- Arranges other local events such as the Christmas Community Concert and St David's Day Concert
- Gets involved in other important events, such as Remembrance Sunday
- Pays for or towards local facilities such as the Abertillery Town Toilets and Winterfest Activities
- Provides support and funding for events such as Aberfest, Winterfest and the Christmas pantomime
- Provides Christmas lights and hanging baskets throughout local areas
- Looks after the Abertillery War Memorial site and other similar facilities
- Is involved in running six allotment sites in the local area
- Makes its views on local issues known to others e.g. Blaenau Gwent Council, the Police, NHS etc
- Works in partnership with others to achieve more for our communities
- Celebrates local successes and community champions and promotes further success
- Is committed to improving community well-being and engaging better with local communities
- Holds meetings which are open to the public, usually on the last Wednesday of every month at 7pm
