Decisions Made:

- (1) Minutes Confirmed
 - a. 22 Feb – One typographical error to amend
 - b. 24 Feb
10 March – Amendment concerning the reporting from BGCBC and Off the Streets.
- (2) Council appoints IAC Audit & Consultancy Ltd as its Internal Auditor
- (3) Council agrees the following work to be conducted at the Abertillery War Memorial (a) Install Iron Benches (b) Jet wash the interior and exterior walls (c) do remedial work to align flower beds with pathways
- (4) The Clerk has been instructed to investigate the possibility of repairing the exterior plastering of the house wall that backs onto the Ware Memorial site, and if possible, to bring back costs to Council.
- (5) Council takes forward working with a Company in providing a Drive-in cinema over the weekend of 23rd to 26th July and use the Party in the Park budget of £13,000 to fund a number of free shows. There will not be a Party in the Park this year.
- (6) Council takes steps to adopt a telephone kiosk in Cwmtillery and work in partnership with a voluntary organisation who have indicated they wish to take this on.
- (7) A grant of £5,990 be awarded to Abertillery Town Band
