What are the aims of the group or project?

LMI is a vibrant hub, working to tackle the effects of poverty, deprivation & isolation within our community. Llanhilleth Ward is in the top 10-20% on the Welsh Index of Multiple Deprivations & the top 10% for poor health & employment. Poor transport links add to people being particularly vulnerable to loneliness and isolation. We provide an unfunded drop-in support service alongside the intensive projects we deliver to combat poverty, provide meaningful activities and improve socialisation & wellbeing. We are requesting a grant of £600 to provide 24 emergency food hampers for families in crisis. Each hamper (costing £25) will provide food and essentials for a family of 4 for 3 days.

How does the group / project benefit the Abertillery and Llanhilleth area or its residents?

The community has come to expect that Llanhilleth Institute is the first port of call in times of crisis, taking a lead in crisis response - such as during the floods in 2020 and 2024. The institute works closely with organisations such as: Women's Aid, the Blaenau Gwent Food Partnership, Llamau homeless project, social services and young carers. In this way we are well positioned to help support families with the most vital provisions when they are at their most desperate and vulnerable. We do not operate as a food bank, but because of our profile as a place where people go in times of crisis, people/families we have helped include those facing domestic abuse and homelessness, along with some refugee families with young children who have no recourse to public funds.
